The ISMIR society is running a nice surplus

- We all owe huge thanks to the successful financial management of previous conferences! (notably 2010, 2016, 2017)
- ISMIR is a non-profit organization (NPO) with no other revenue
- This is what allows the society to fund students,
 WiMIR grants, and other initiatives

Budget Proposal: Four part plan

- 1. Continue making ISMIR accessible: students, WiMIR, nonaffiliated researchers
- 2. Support for high-quality scientific papers at TISMIR (open access fees, copy editing)
- 3. Commemorate ISMIR's 20th anniversary
- 4. ISMIR organizers, e.g. softconf, ISBNs, cover some costs to reduce the financial risk

- Complimentary data hosting, i.e. additional redundancy



- Host static sites for free
- Version control
- Automatic deployments
- Submit changes, e.g. fixes, updates, directly from the browser

Websites

The main site is moving to **Jekyll**

- Write websites in simple plaintext markdown, e.g. READMEs
- GitHub Pages automatically builds and deploys
- Happily mixes markdown, HTML, CSS, ...

Epic wins

- **Easier to develop:** no need to be a web-dev
- Future-proof: produces a static site


